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5. ENTRY PROCESS

It is required that respective participating National Federations confirm the technical and medical standard of the boxers and other Team Members. Participating National Federations are also responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their Team, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the entry process is accurate. NFs will be requested to enter the U23 European Championships by submitting a Phase 1 Entry by Number & Accommodation Request Form. Phase 2 Entry by Name will request full information. Rooming lists and transport information will be requested separately.

Registering reserve boxers is strongly encouraged to allow for substitutions after the entry deadline prior to the Sport Entries Check without penalties.

5.1 Accompanying Team Members

The total number of Team Officials that may be accredited per NF depends on the number of competing Boxers. Each Team Delegation may include the following accredited Team Officials:

- 1 Team Manager
- 1 Team Doctor (must be registered within their NOC/NF)
- 1 Physiotherapist
- 1 Dietitian/Nutritionist
- Coaches with ringside access:

o 1-3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches o 4-8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches o 9-20 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that all Team Members are qualified to perform their duties.

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5.2 Sports Entries Check

The Sport Entries check is the final part of the event entry process, and it will take place on 21 November at the Danubius Hotel Arena. European Boxing and the LOC will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event.

The Sport Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive on time for their respective appointments.

Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Sport Entries check (e.g. Team Manager and the Team Doctor).

In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Copy of Passport
- o Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Medical Certificate issued within the previous three months, signed by the National Federation Doctor
- o Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (women boxers only), signed by the boxer/legal guardian
- Uniforms per European Boxing Competition Rules
- Signed Conditions of Participation Form for each Team Member (If form not previously submitted online)
- Signed European Boxing Code of Conduct (If form not previously submitted online)

To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditations, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs with the LOC. Important: Failure to attend the Sport Entries Check per scheduled appointment by any Team will lead to the exclusion of the entire Team from taking part in the event with all accommodation and fees payable to the LOC forfeit.

6. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

LOC will provide assistance to participating Teams requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition.

Passports of all Championships participants must be valid for at least six months from the date of arrival and must contain blank page(s) for visa(s) and stamps.



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7. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The designated airport for arrival and departure of Teams is **Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport (BUD)**. All Teams must submit their arrival and departure details to the LOC.

8. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will provide airport transfers to official hotels for Teams on official arrival and departure days. If delegations are using an unofficial hotel or an official hotel, not reserved through the LOC, they are not allowed to use the official event transportation. Additional transportation costs will apply when airport transfers or any other transportation is required outside of event days and costings will be sought on request.

10. ACCOMODATION / EVENT HOTELS

Participating Teams must book their accommodation in the Event Hotels via the LOC (not directly with the hotel).

All Teams must submit their accommodation request and rooming list to the LOC via https://www.boxing.hu/u23budapestregistration by the dates listed earlier.



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IMPORTANT NOTICE

After the Phase 1 Entry Deadline, all accommodation will be released by the LOC and may not be available for nations that have not made any bookings. It is important to note that All Nations will be committed to the room bookings they make at the Phase 1 Entry Deadline. We advise you to book your minimum requirement and liaise with the LOC on any increases that are required should your numbers change following the Phase 1 Entry.

Any damage to Event Hotel property resulting from the stay of a Team will be charged to the respective National Federation and must be paid in full. Delegations are kindly requested not to dry clothing or have training sessions in the corridors of the Event Hotels.

Only accredited Event participants will be allowed to stay in the Event Hotels. Teams are being offered a 9-night package for their stay in Budapest. Rates are full board and include 3 meals per day and transportation between hotels and official airports on official travel days. All meals for registered attendees will be served in their respective hotels, and delegation members will only be permitted to eat in the hotel they are staying in for all meals.

The first meal of the 9-night package is dinner, served on 21 November, and the last meal served is breakfast, 30 November. The 9-night package is based on arrival Thursday 21 November and departure Sunday 30 November.

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11. IMAGE RIGHTS

The LOC will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All training sessions will be open to the accredited media unless a Team specifically requests otherwise. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to European Boxing and the LOC. Video recording of bouts by for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed. National Federations may only record bouts of their boxers using one camera per ring if for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose.

12. MEDICAL SERVICES

The LOC will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

13. ANTI-DOPING

Doping controls will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted.

14. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.
