#### REGULATIONS

- The tournament shall be organized in accordance with the <u>World Boxing</u> Competition Rules.
- TopTen gloves and headguards will be provided by the Local Organizing Committee (LOC).
- The Swiss Timing System will be used for scoring and timing.
- There will be a maximum of 8 boxers per weight category, as limited by the number of competition days.
- Depending on the total number of participants, the tournament can be held in two rings.

Elite boxers	born from 1 January 1985 to 31 December 2006
Youth boxers	born from 1 January 2007 to 31 December 2008
Junior boxers	born from 1 January 2009 to 31 December 2010
Schoolage boxers	born from 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2012

#### **WEIGHT CATEGORIES**

Participation is limited to one (1) boxer per club per weight category. If a team wishes to register more than one boxer in the same weight category, please contact the LOC — additional entries may be accepted subject to availability.

Elite men: 9 weight categories

55 kg, 60 kg, 65 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 85 kg, 90kg, 90+ kg;

Elite woman: 1 weight categories

60 kg

Youth men: 10 weight categories

50 kg, 55 kg, 60 kg, 65 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 85 kg, 90kg, 90+ kg;













# Junior men: 13 weight categories

46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 57 kg, 60 kg, 63 kg, 66 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, 80 kg, 80+ kg.

Junior women: 2 weight category

60 kg, 80 kg

Schoolage boys: 9 age categories

42 kg, 44 kg, 46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 60 kg, 66 kg

Schoolage girls: 2 age categories

48 kg, 50 kg

#### **PARTICIPATION FEE**

Every team will be obligated to pay participation fee **30.- eur** per each boxer.

## **REFEREE & JUDGES**

The referees and judges (R&Js) must have an WB license. We hope that all participating teams will bring along their R&Js to ensure the highest level of judging. Referees and Judges are subject to confirmation by the Local Organizing Committee (LOC). The LOC may request that another R&J be delegated for this event by the participating National Federation.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

All boxers must have:

- Record Books of each boxer (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Valid passport or ID card of each boxer
- Two sets of Boxing Uniforms (red/blue) according to WB Competition rules
- Gumshield, footwear, bandages/handwraps, protectors

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Travel costs and logistical arrangements are the responsibility of the participating teams.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

All accommodation costs must be paid in full by **September 20th, 2025**, via bank transfer. Accreditations and room keys will not be issued until the full payment has been received by the LOC.

Please request a corresponding invoice from the LOC before making the payment to ensure that the total amount is correct.

Any damage caused to hotel property during the stay will be charged to the respective National Federation and must be compensated in full. Delegations are kindly asked not to dry clothing or conduct training sessions in the corridors of the event hotel.

#### **INSURANCE**

All participants are responsible for their own medical and travel insurance. The organizer does not provide medical Insurance.

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES**

The LOC will provide first aid throughout the entire event period for any participant who suffers from a sports injury incurred during the event.

#### **COMMUNICATION**

For the Tallinn OPEN 2025 Boxing Tournament, the following official communication channels will be used between the Local Organizing Committee (LOC) and the teams:

- **Operational Communication via WhatsApp Group**: A dedicated WhatsApp group will be created for real-time operational communication. Team representatives will be added to this group to ensure quick and efficient exchange of information. To ensure that team representatives are added to this group, teams must provide the relevant contact details to the LOC during the registration process.
- Sportity App Channel (Sports Events App): All tournament-related information, including results, photos, and updates, will be available on the Sportity app. Each participant can access this app by downloading it and logging in with the password provided by the LOC.

These channels are established to facilitate smooth and effective communication throughout the event.













### **IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING**

The LOC will film the event for broadcast and promotional purposes, and official event photographers will take still images of the boxers before and during the event. All sessions will be open to accredited media.

By participating in the event, each team member agrees to release their image rights to the LOC.

#### OTHER PRACTICAL INFO

1. **Average temperatures:** The weather is usually cool with daytime temperatures ranging between 10-15°C (50-59°F). Night temperatures can drop to 5-10°C (41-50°F). Moderate to strong winds are possible. Rain is fairly common during this period, so expect a chance of showers. It is recommended to take an umbrella with you so as not to fall into the rain.

## 2. Language Preferences in Tallinn:

**Estonian**: The primary language used in formal and everyday communication.

**English**: Widely used in international and official contexts.

**Russian**: Used occasionally, especially in specific contexts or among certain communities.

Please be aware that communication in these languages may vary depending on the situation and audience.

- 3. **Currency**: euro (EUR)
- **4. Time zone:** Tallinn, Estonia time is 1 hours ahead of CET. So, when it is 11:00 am CET it will be 12:00 pm in Tallinn.
- 5. **Transport services for your local trips in Tallinn**: use the **Bolt** app for this purpose. With this software, you can order a taxi, rent a Bolt car (car sharing service), rent a scooter, or even order food delivery (**BoldFood** app). In order to use the service, you need to install the application on your smartphone and connect a payment card. We strongly recommend that you ride a scooter along the Pirita promenade and the Reidi road.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PLACES TO VISIT IN TALLINN

## 1. Tallinna Vanalinn (Tallinn Old Town)

Explore the charming medieval old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, known for its cobblestone streets, historic buildings, and picturesque squares. Highlights include the Raekoja plats (Town Hall Square), Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, and the remnants of the city wall.

## 2. Kadriorg Palace and Park

Visit the beautiful Kadriorg Palace, built by Peter the Great for his wife Catherine I. The palace is surrounded by a lovely park with walking paths, gardens, and the KUMU Art Museum.

## 3. Toompea Hill

Climb Toompea Hill for stunning panoramic views of the city. The area is home to the Estonian Parliament, the medieval Toompea Castle, and St. Mary's Cathedral.

## 4. Seaplane Harbour (Lennusadam)

Discover the Seaplane Harbour Museum, which features an impressive collection of maritime artifacts, including historic ships and submarines. The unique seaplane hangars offer an engaging experience for visitors.

## 5. Telliskivi Creative City

Explore the vibrant Telliskivi district, a creative hub with trendy boutiques, art galleries, and street art. It's a great place to experience Tallinn's contemporary culture and enjoy local cafes and restaurants.

#### 6. Pikk Hermann Tower

Visit the Pikk Hermann Tower, which is part of the Toompea Castle complex. The tower offers a great view of the city and is significant in Estonian history as the site where the national flag is raised.

#### 7. Tallinn TV Tower

Head to the Tallinn TV Tower for breathtaking views of the city and its surroundings from the observation deck. The tower also offers interactive exhibits and a restaurant.
